Summary of duties and responsibilities:

The Architect provides architectural support and coordination on a wide variety of development projects.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

Hours:

- Construction Documents:
 - Scope and responsibilities will be determined on a project-by-project basis.
 - Large projects: Bid, contract with, and manage 3rd party consultants as Owner's Representative.
 - Small projects: Self-perform architectural and lead project engineers on all phases of design.
 - Prepare as-built plans for minor-works projects, including site visits for field measurements, etc.
 - Develop complete set of Tenant Improvement (TI) construction documents, including drawings and specifications.
 - Manage, submit, and track agency reviews and permit applications.
 - Interact with clients and tenants in order to develop an accurate and complete set of construction documents.
- Construction
 - Assist with bidding and construction administration.
 - Track historic construction costs and assist with forecasting/budgeting.
- Development
 - Assist developer and clients with programming site requirements.
 - Prepare schematic site plans, including building layout and parking field design.
- Property Management, Asset Management, and Leasing Support:
 - Assist with preparation of leasing floor plan exhibits and tenant evacuation plans. Able to analyze construction/development costs and understand the impact of these on the development
 - Maintains all project records per the office record keeping system
 - Monitors project closeout process including contract closeouts, punch list and final payments.
 - Reviews monthly draw for conformance with Operating Agreement requirements
 - Aware of the sales and marketing activities, and understands how these relate to status of construction

Qualifications:

- 3 years of relevant experience
- Bachelor's in Architecture required; Professional license preferred
- Excellent computer skills, with emphasis on Word, Excel, Power Point, Internet access,

AutoCad experience is beneficial

- Proficiency in AutoCAD, Revit, Word, Excel, Adobe Suites, Bluebeam, MS Project, and similar platforms are preferred
- A strong working knowledge of the principles and practices of architectural and interior design is required.
- Successful candidates must have the ability to organize, coordinate, plan, maintain schedules, and to work well under pressure.
